<p>CPLP citizens are exempt from presenting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Travel insurance, Return transport ticket; and, a) Means of support, upon presentation of a sponsorship letter (AIMA's model 4 form) with a legalised signature, signed by a Portuguese citizen or a foreign citizen with a residence permit in Portugal, covering lodging and boarding, as well as the replacement of removal costs, in case of irregular stay, along with: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Certificate of incorporation of the subscriber's household; - Subscriber's tax return (last year); and - Subscriber's bank statement (last 3 months). 	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
