	 If you are married to an EU/EEA citizen, a copy of marriage certificate (join original for verification) If the marriage certificate presented is from a third country it must be transcript in the national EU/EAA member state law (example: if you got married in Pakistan please present the Pakistani marriage certificate + (plus) the Portuguese marriage certificate) 		
5	Copy of birth certificate (*)		
	If one or both of your parents are EU/EEA citizen, a copy of the birth certificate (join original for verification)		
6	Copy of birth certificate of the son/daughter you depend on (*)		
	If you are a dependent ascendant of an EU/EEA citizen, a copy of birth certificate of the son/daughter you depend on (join original for verification)		
7	Documentation that the EU/EEA national is exercising his/her right to free movement
