CPLP citizens are exempt from presenting: - Travel insurance, - Return transport ticket; and, - Means of support, upon presentation of a sponsorship letter, with a legalised signature, issued by a Portuguese or a foreign citizen with a residence permit in Portugal, covering lodging and boarding, as well as all the removal costs, in case of irregular stay, accompanied by the following supporting documents: - Income Tax Return (IRS) of the subscriber (last year available); and - Bank statements of the subscriber (last 3 months).	☐ ☐ ☐	☐ ☐ ☐
