

Consular Section of the Embassy of Portugal in Dakar Visas for family members of EU citizens

Simplified Information Sheet

This application can only be accepted if the applicant is a family member of an EU or Swiss national, in accordance with Directive 2004/38/EC, and is accompanying or intends to join the EU national in Portugal. The following are considered to be family members

- Spouse;
- Children under the age of 21 or who can prove that they are dependent on him/her;
 - Dependent relatives in the direct ascending line of the European national or his/her spouse.

DOCUMENTS TO BE PRESENTED		
Correctly completed form (Schengen form for short-term visits or National Visa form for family reunification)		
Passport valid for at least three months after the planned date of return		
A recent passport photo in colour on a white background (3.5 x 4.5 cm)		
Valid travel booking (return)		
Proof of family relationship with an EU national (copy of birth certificate and family record book duly legalised or apostilled, copy of marriage certificate, etc.)		
A declaration or a signed statement of responsibility by the EU national stating that he/she is accompanying the family member or that the family member is joining him/her.		
Photocopy of the identification document of the accompanying or joining European national		
Proof of accommodation during the visit: confirmation of accommodation provided by the host or proof of financial means to cover accommodation costs or confirmation of private accommodation indicating that the host will cover costs or proof of rental or ownership of a property.		
Minors: proof that the minor will be accompanied by his or her parents or authorisation to leave the country from both parents or from the parent not travelling with the child with a recognised signature (present the death certificate in the event of the death of one of the parents or proof of sole custody where applicable).		

The applicant declares that he/she is aware that: i) failure to present all the necessary documents or the presentation of invalid documents may result in the visa application being refused; ii) the consular post will not accept the visa application unless the applicant has presented all the necessary documents. additional documents; iii) the employer's signature on contracts and terms of liability must be acknowledged by a Portuguese lawyer or notary; iv) presentation of all the documents listed does not automatically result in a visa being granted; and v) refusal of a visa does not entitle the applicant to reimbursement of expenses..
