| CPLP citizens are exempt from presenting: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Travel insurance; Return transport ticket; and Means of support, upon presentation of a sponsorship letter, with legalised signature, issued by a Portuguese citizen or a foreign citizen with a residence permit in Portugal, covering lodging and boarding, as well as the replacement of removal costs, in case of irregular stay. | | |
| Notes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Failure to submit all the necessary documents may lead to the rejection of the visa application. The Consular Post reserves the right to request documents other than those mentioned above whenever deemed convenient. Even if all the requested documents are presented, it doesn't imply the automatic granting of the visa. Refusal of the visa application shall not entitle to a reimbursement of the visa fee.
