<p>National Visa application filled in and duly signed by the applicant (or by the legal guardian in case of minors or the disabled);</p> <p>2 identical passport-sized photographs, recent and in good condition to identify the applicant (1 attached to the form).</p>		
<p>Passport or other travel document, valid for at least 3 months beyond the intended period of stay;</p> <p>Photocopy of passport (biographical data).</p>		
<p>Proof of regular status, if of other nationality than that of the country where applying for a visa, valid beyond the date of expiry of the visa you are applying for.</p>		
<p>Valid travel insurance, covering necessary medical expenses, including urgent medical assistance and possible repatriation.</p>		
<p>Police clearance certificate, issued by the competent authority of the country of the applicant's nationality or of the country where the applicant has resided for over a year (not required for minors under sixteen years of age), with the Hague Apostille (if applicable) or legalised.</p> <p>Note: Police clearance is required to be submitted with a UAE MoFA stamp.</p>		
<p>Copy of the return transport ticket.</p>		
<p>Proof of means of support: For the purposes of proof of means of support, the following must be considered:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The means derived from training grants and subsidies; or, • The presentation of a sponsorship letter, with a legalised signature, issued by the host entity.

<p>Document issued by an officially recognized educational or professional training establishment certifying the admission to a course with a duration of less than one year; and</p>		
<p>Proof of means of support and accommodation.</p>
