In the case of patients traveling under Cooperation Agreements, proof of means of subsistence and proof of accommodation may be replaced by a statement from the Embassy of his/her country in Lisbon guaranteeing the conditions.

Document proving the family bond that justifies the accompaniment.			
Proof of the availability of stable and regular resources, sufficient for the needs of the temporary stay visa applicant and the accompanying family member, for the requested period of stay.			
Patients/ familiars traveling under Cooperation Agreements, the applicant must provide a document issued by a medical committee and the proof that a medical appointment was scheduled in Portugal.			
ADITIONAL DOCUMENTS FOR MINORS			
Minors who are not traveling with both parents or are traveling with a third person: must present a travel authorization, with a recognized signature, duly legalized, from the parent with whom they are not traveling or both, or a court decision (when applicable) authorizing the minor to travel and stay in Portugal during the foreseen period according to the reason for the stay.
