<b>Proof of financial resources</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>U.K. Bank Statements:</b> Provide bank statements from the last 3 months.</li> <li><b>Portuguese Bank Statement:</b> An up-to-date Portuguese bank statement showing proof of deposited funds of at least €10 440 for a single applicant, along with the applicant's NIF.</li> </ul> <p><i>If applying with additional family members, the required financial resources are calculated based on the minimum monthly salary for 2024, which is €870 (PCM Regulatory Decree No. 85-A/2022, of 22<sup>nd</sup> December), net of taxes and social security deductions. <p>Notes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Failure to submit all the necessary documents may lead to the rejection of the visa application.</li> <li>• The Consular Post reserves the right to request documents other than those mentioned above whenever deemed convenient.</li> <li>• Even if all the requested documents are presented, it doesn't imply the automatic granting of the visa.
