

Portugal – Residency - Checklist for Long Stay (type D)

Visas are issued to persons who intend to resettle permanently in

Portugal for:

- a) Retirement
- b) Independent living
- c) To establish independent business
- d) To set up investments
- e) To establish themselves as independent professionals in their field
- f) To Work Remotly while receiving income from the US
- g) To study

Note:

All residency visas are valid for a period of 120 calendar days. Once in Portugal, all residency visa holders need to report to an office of the *Serviço de Estrangeiros e Fronteiras* (SEF) to apply for a Permanent Residency Card

1	1 Visa applications completely filled and duly signed by applicant (Notarized if sent by mail)					
2	2 recent color photographs (4.5cm X 3.5cm) must accompany the application form					
3	Notarized copies of passport or official travel document valid for at least 3 months					
	beyond date of intended stay in Portugal. The original passport must be submitted once					
	the visa is approved.					
4	If not a US citizen, proof of legal status, copies front and back (green card, US visa,					
	advance parole etc.). Specify:					
5	Personal Statement: signed by applicant specifying reason for settling in Portugal,					
	intended area of residency and type of accommodations (rental, purchase of private					
	property, or family home					
6	Confirmed Accommodation for the first 6 months, stating name, address and telephone					
	number of the hotel, including confirmation number.					
	For study purpose,: confirmed accommodation from the inviting institution if on campus					
	or confirmed hotel reservations for the first 6 months, stating name, address and					
	telephone number of the hotel, including confirmation number					
7	Proof of financial support : Proof of financial support may be established by opening of a					
	bank account in Portugal. Proof of assets W-2 forms, income and last 3 months of bank					
	statements (electronic print outs are accepted, It is imperative to have the address where					
	the customer legally resides in the USA, same as application, ID's, etc.); Proof of Pension:					
	proof of work remotely or proof of passive income.					
8	FBI Criminal Record Certificate (for applicants older than 16 years old). This document					
	must be requested with an apostille or remain unopened in original sealed envelope.					
9	Permission to the Department of Borders (SEF) to obtain criminal record from Portugal					
10	Copy of marriage certificate and children's birth certificate (in case of a family)					
11	Proof of Health Insurance that covers medical expenses in Portugal through the duration					
	of stay (insurance must not exclude COVID19)
