Portugal - TEMPORARY/ RESI DENCY WORK VISAS - Checklist for Long Stay type D

- Temporary work visas allowbearers to engage in a paid professional activity, in Portugal, from 1 month to up to 3 years, either under contract to an employer or for self-employment.
- Applications are processed at Consulate and for warded to the Portuguese I mmi gration authorities for consideration. A final answer may be
 received within 1 or 2 months. If application is approved, a visa will be issued by the Consulate.
- Accompanying family members who are nationals of countries that require Schengen visas must apply for a short stay visa and adjust
 their status with Portuguese I mmi gration authorities (SEF) once in Portugal. Short stay visas do not allow holders to engage in paid
 activities in Portugal.

Accompanying family members who are nationals of countries that **do not** require Schengen visas must enter the country using their passport (without a visa) and adjust their status with Portuguese I mmigration authorities (SEF) once in Portugal

3	Not arized copies of pass port or official travel document valid for at least 3 months beyond date of intended stay in Portugal. The original pass port must be submitted once the visa is approved.		
4	If not a US citizen, proof of legal status <u>copy front and back</u> (green card, US visa, advance pard e etc.). Specify:		
5	Work contract, signed by both parties confirming period of employment, salary, benefits, proof of financial support, and housing/accommodations while in Portugal. These documents must be either in Portuguese or translated		
6	Confir med Accommodation: from the inviting institution or confirmed hotel reservations, stating name, address and telephone number of the hotel, including confirmation number.		
7	Proof of financial support ; Last 3 months of bank statements (electronic print outs are accepted);		
8	FBI Cri mind Record Certificate (for applicants of der than 15). This document must be requested with an apostille or remain unopened in original sed ed envelope.		
9	Per mission to the Department of Borders and Customs to obtain criminal record from Portugal		
10	Copy of marriage certificate and chil dren's birth certificate (in case of a family).		
11	Proof of Health Insurance that covers medical expenses in Portugal through the duration of stay (insurance must not exclude COM D19)
