Please note that if the application is not complete upon submission, it risks being refused

- Passport valid for at least 3 months after the expiry date of the visa containing at least two blank pages
- A recent copy of the passport
- Application form completed and signed by the applicant (if minor, signed by parent(s))
- Proof of residence in Morocco for non-Moroccan nationals: Moroccan residence card (or proof of renewal request)

Proof of EU/EEA citizen's nationality

- Copy of the passport identity page of the EU/EEA citizen, or other identity document showing EU/EEA citizen's nationality

Proof of being a family member of the EU/EEA

For example:

- Marriage certificate
- Birth certificate/legalized court decision on custody of the child indicating the relationship with the EU/EEA citizen
- Other documentation showing that you fall under the category of a "family member" of an EU/EEA citizen who benefits from the rights granted under Directive 2004/38/EC (Free Movement Directive), e.g. evidence relating to dependency.

Minors (under 18) travelling alone or without one of the parents/legal guardians

- Original letter of authorization signed by parents/legal guardians duly legalized
- If one parent has a sole custody: a copy of court decision or other proof of custody
- Copies of non-travelling parent(s) passports and Moroccan residence permits

If accompanying the EU/EEA national

- Proof of traveling together with an EU/EEA family member to Sweden/Iceland

For example:

- Confirmation that EU/EEA will travel to Sweden/Iceland or confirmation of common journey or, travel and accommodation arrangements, copy of flight reservations for both the applicant and his/her EU/EEA family member

If joining an EU/EEA national

- Proof of joining an EU/EEA family member in Sweden/Iceland

For example:

- Evidence of EU/EEA citizen's right of residence in Sweden/Iceland (if EU/EEA citizen's residence in Sweden/Iceland is three months or longer)

Additional documents

The applicant may submit other or additional documents that are relevant to his/her situation.

The Swedish Embassy may request additional information or documents, and if deemed necessary, conduct an interview with the applicant by telephone or in person.

It is not necessary to present a valid travel insurance, but the Embassy strongly recommends travelling with it.
