

Checklist for National Visa: Family Reunification

Application for a family reunification visa has to be submitted **personally** at the Visa Section, Embassy of Switzerland, Chandragupta Marg, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi - 110 021. In order to schedule an appointment with the Embassy, please visit the following link and book an appointment online:

The authorization lies in the competence of the migration office of the respective canton in Switzerland, therefore kindly submit 3 application forms and 2 sets of the required documents as specified below:

Valid national passport :			
0	Issued within the last 10 years and with at least 3 months validity after the scheduled return, with at least two blank pages. Handwritten passports and passports with observations regarding the front page (bio data) cannot be accepted		
4 x	4 x passport size pictures:		
0	3 pictures, recently taken, white background, pasted on the applications - the 4 th picture to be clipped on the last page of the passport, stapled or pinned pictures cannot be accepted.

Please note:

- The required documents have to be submitted in person with the visa application (no fax or e-mail to Embassy accepted).
- Only the required documents mentioned on the checklist are accepted.
- The Embassy of Switzerland reserves the right to ask for additional documents and/or for a personal interview.

Procedure:

The entire application will be forwarded to the competent cantonal migration office for its decision (6-12 weeks). Information regarding the processing time will be given by the authorities in Switzerland only.

Once the authorization to enter Switzerland has been granted (form "Ermächtigung zur Visumerteilung" or "Autorisation habilitant les représentations Suisses à délivrer un visa"), the passport and the authorization can be submitted directly to VFS Global Services by the applicant or by a third person without prior appointment.

The entry visa will allow you to travel through the Schengen states and enter Switzerland during its validity. Within the first 14 days of your initial entry you will have to declare your arrival at the Residents Registration Office at your place of residence (German: Einwohnerkontrolle, French: Contrôle des habitants; Italian: Controllo degli abitanti). The residence permit will be issued upon notification of your arrival in Switzerland.

Voluntary verification:

Your official documents might have to be verified and legalized by this Embassy, which would take 3 months and costs CHF 1'000.00.

The decision to do so will be taken by the Swiss authorities after having received your application file.

In order to speed up the handling of your file, you could opt to ask the Embassy to do this verification process before sending the file to Switzerland.
