Valid national passport :		
0	Issued within the last 10 years and with at least 3 months validity after the scheduled return, with at least two blank pages. Handwritten passports and passports with observations regarding the front page (bio data) cannot be accepted.	
1 passport size picture:		
0	White background, not older than 6 months (size 35 – 40 mm in width, not copied or scanned picture). Picture to be pasted on the application form, stapled or pinned pictures cannot be accepted. 0	Completed and signed by the applicant, if applicable, authorization of third person.	
0	If the applicant is a minor: visa application signed by legal guardian/s and if applicable, authorization of third person.	
	(Proving the custody of a minor child, divorce papers, death certificate etc.).	
<b>Proof of family bonds:</b> birth certificate, marriage certificate, partnership etc., registered as per the Schengen/Swiss law, along with the passport copy of the family member with Swiss/Schengen nationality		
Marriage/Birth registered as per Indian laws will not be considered as a valid proof for obtaining exemptions		
Travel Insurance (recommended but not mandatory):

0	Minimum coverage of 30,000 Euro/ 50,000 CHF per person.	
0	Coverage of all expenses which might arise in connection with repatriation for medical reasons, urgent medical attention and/or emergency hospital treatment.	
0	The insurance has to cover the entire stay within the Schengen territory.	
0	Applicants who wish to apply for a six months or a one year multiple visa are not obliged to provide a 180 (365) day coverage. It is sufficient to submit an insurance policy covering the first journey.	
0	Visa fees:	
	Adults: free of charge  Obildon between 0 and 40 years olds free of charge.	
	Children between 6 and 12 years old: free of charge  Ohildren and day Conserve olds free of charge.	
	Children under 6 years old: free of charge

- The required documents have to be submitted with the visa application (no fax or e-mail to Embassy accepted)
- Only the documents mentioned on the checklist are accepted
- The Embassy of Switzerland reserves the right to ask for additional documents and/or for a personal interview
- If your marriage/birth is not registered as per the Swiss/Schengen law, then please apply for your visa as per the regular visitor's visa checklist and the visa fee is chargeable as well.
